

ACTION PAPER**07/04/2015****AGENDA ITEM: Detailed presentation of the Regional Programme on Air Transport****EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

In accordance with the high level objectives stemming from South East Europe 2020 Strategy – Jobs and Prosperity in a European Perspective, adopted at ministerial level on November 21 2013 in Sarajevo, SEETO – as a Transport Dimension Coordinator, and JSPA Initiative – as a Regional Structure in coordination with the RCC, prepared and delivered Regional Programme: *Harmonized and optimized use of regional airspace with enhanced air transport connectivity in the SEE.*

The Regional Programme is consisted of five (5) interconnected projects, which are structured as:

- those dealing with facilitation of regional air traffic (namely: SEE Airspace Study, FRA Implementation in SEE, PBN Implementation Plan in SEE and WAM/MLAT Feasibility Study), and
- one dealing with enhancement of regional air transport (Elaboration of a new air transport connections within the SEE region).

The Action Paper provides the current status of projects and their structure as profiled by the delivered Regional Programme on Air Transport.

During the last DG/CEO meeting Mr. Aleksandar Djordjevic, CAA of Montenegro, has been elected as a coordinator of Regional Programme on Air Transport, supported by sub-team leaders and experts (Reference: Memo from Tivat DG/CEOs meeting, the ad hoc JSPA meeting in Budapest, 05.02.2015 and meeting notes from the extended Preparatory Team meeting 1-2 December 2014, Budapest).

The JSPA Initiative Preparatory Team members are invited to note the Regional Programme on Air Transport and acknowledge the current JSPA priority projects structure and their status of implementation.
